

## Twinsburg Garden Club Meeting Minutes April 11, 2024

- Mary Ann Aardema and Kristen Rocco brought refreshments.
- Treasurer's Report – Valerie Wales reported that there is \$5076.67 in our bank account. Member, Judy Frohman, has conducted an accounting audit. Everything is in good shape.
- Revised By-Laws – Judy Aplis introduced a motion to approve the By-Laws that had been sent to members in advance. Bev Helser seconded the motion followed by Sally Pate. There was no discussion and the revised By-Laws were approved with no dissention.
- Yearbook – if anyone needs a 2024 Yearbook, see Judy Aplis
- Seed Library – Kristen Beason reported that the Seed Library has been a great success. Some seed varieties are running low.
- Plant Sale – at the May meeting, we will be making plant identifier sticks for personal use by members and to sell at the plant sale. Cost is \$10/5 sticks. The money and tile order form, are due today.  
Virginia Schmidt reported that members are asked to donate 5-10 perennials from their yards for the sale. Please label all donated plants with a description of their height, sun/shade, etc. If you need pots for your plants, call Virginia. Plants can be dropped off at the barn on Wednesday afternoon, 5/8, or on Friday, 5/10 after noon. No plants will be accepted for donation on the day of the sale.  
Set up at the barn will take place on 5/4 (6-8 volunteers are needed). New signs have been ordered to place around T-Burg the day of the sale. During sale week, on W, Th, F, the plants will be priced and pre-ordered plants will be delivered to members. On the day of the sale, arrive at 8 am to help. Sale ends at noon.
- Library Programs – Sue Davis reported that about 60 people attended the program on beneficial bugs. On April 25/26, there will be a Mini-Golf event at the library. Adults can enjoy cocktails on 4/25 and a family event is scheduled for 4/26. See the library website for details.
- Club Outings – Mary Gemlich and her group are working on scheduling more outings this summer.
- Scholarships – Valerie Wales reported that there were no applicants for the scholarship program. Suggestions were made to try to increase awareness – expand pool to include all HS students living in Twinsburg (not just those attending T-Burg HS), and approach PTA groups.
